1 **TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:**

2 Following the July 26, 2018 Jury Verdict, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

3 Judgment be entered in favor of Defendant Windermere Real Estate Services
4 Company and against Plaintiffs Bennion & Deville Fine Homes, Inc., Bennion &
5 Deville Fine Homes SoCal, Inc., and Windermere Services Southern California, Inc.
6 on all claims asserted in the First Amended Complaint.

7 Judgment be entered in favor of Counter-Claimant Windermere Real Estate
8 Services Company on the claims asserted in the First Amended Counter Claim as
9 follows:

10 Windermere Real Estate Services Company shall have and recover from
11 Bennion & Deville Fine Homes, Inc. (“B&D Fine Homes”) the sum of One Million,
12 Two Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand, Five Hundred Fifty-Five and 32/100 Dollars
13 (\$1,264,555.32);

14 Windermere Real Estate Services Company shall have and recover from
15 Bennion & Deville Fine Homes SoCal, Inc. (“B&D Fine Homes SoCal”) the sum of
16 Three Hundred Ten Thousand, Two Hundred Thirty-Four and 98/100 Dollars
17 (\$310,234.98);

18 Of the amounts owed by B&D Fine Homes and B&D Fine Homes SoCal,
19 Robert L. Bennion and Joseph R. Deville are each jointly and severally liable for
20 Five Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand, Six Hundred Nineteen and 56/100 Dollars
21 (\$547,619.56); and


